

Environmental stewardship opportunities for high school students!

The Pacific Beach Coalition welcomes teen volunteers to earn community service hours while giving back to their community.

One Time Volunteering:

- Participate in a beach cleanup or habitat restoration event (2 hours per event). PBC events occur every weekend at 10+ locations on the Bay Area's Peninsula.
- Complete Street to Beach Cleanups at the location of your choosing (1+ hr). Record your effort through CleanSwell app and follow up with us for verification via e-mail.

Ongoing: Join our Teen Program

- Teen Site Captain (2 hrs/month) assist in running cleanup and habitat restoration events, under supervision of trained adults, for dedicated high school students only.
- Volunteer at annual special events like July 4th cleanup, Earth Day, California Coastal Cleanup Day, and other occasions.

- Join social events: Various events like hikes, tidepooling trips, youth-only cleanups, environmental talks, member meetings, are available to PBC teen-only social events.
- Grow Leadership skills: Teen Site Captains assist with monthly cleanups and can lead environmental projects of their choosing.
- Gain Communication skills by speaking with the volunteers who attend events via giving directions to volunteers during events, giving a short speech at events, and documenting PBC stories through blog posts, or creating social media posts. Social media internships are a possibility.
